Hi, my name is Janell Salmon and I am the Outreach Coordinator for InterVarsity Christian Fellowship. This semester, we've been going through a series titled "If I Could Ask God Anything..." where we've addressed questions about God and Christianity that are commonly asked in our society. In our culture, there is a projected view of what Christianity says about sexuality, specifically homosexuality, that often stems from misunderstanding, lack of desire to explore other perspectives, hatred, and bigotry from both sides of the discussion.
