National President announces closing of the Phi Chi Phi Chapter at the State University of New York - Binghamton

Neptune, NJ, November 30, 2012

The National President has issued a summary suspension of the Phi Chi Phi Chapter at the State University of New York - Binghamton. This decision is based upon the investigation into hazing allegations. The Phi Chi Phi Chapter has thirty days to appeal this decision.

Alpha Chi Rho has a long standing position against hazing. It deems hazing antithetical to our values, ideals and landmarks.

The closing of this Chapter underscores the importance of following the policies of the National Fraternity, the host institution and state laws.

Our mission: Alpha Chi Rho is a men's collegiate fraternity whose purpose is to enhance the lifelong intellectual, moral and social development of our members through the guidance of our landmarks.

Our landmarks:

1. Membership from among those who are prepared to realize in word and deed, the Brotherhood of all men.
